In the Year One Thousand Eight hundred fifty Eight.

An Ordinance in addition to an Ordinance  
in relation to the duties of the City Messenger,

Be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Cambridge  
as follows-

The City Messenger shall attend  
to letting the Halls connected with the City  
Hall & shall attend to the opening & closing  
of same under such regulations as the Mayor  
& Aldermen may establish; he shall col-  
lect & pay into the City Treasury all monies  
due for rent of the Halls,

In Board of Aldermen, May 12. 1858.

Amended by adding two sections as follows - viz -

Sec 2 The City Messenger shall receive an annual salary of five hundred dollars, in equal quarterly payments commencing on the first day of April last past, which shall be in full for all services rendered by him in that capacity.

Sec 3 So much of an ordinance in relation to salaries of City Officers in the Municipal register page one hundred and twenty seven ~~is here~~ as relates to the City Messenger is hereby repealed.
