City of Cambridge

(Order to construct Main Drain or Common Sewers
General Laws, Tercentenary Edition, Chapter 83)

IN CITY COUNCIL

June 29, 1959.

WHEREAS:-

It is adjudged necessary for the public convenience and the public health that a main drain or common sewer should be laid out, made, constructed and maintained in certain private ways as follows:-

From the present man-hole in Acorn Park, thence northerly and northeasterly through private land, 720 feet to Concord Turnpike; thence, westerly along Concord Turnpike 400 feet, a total of approximately 1120 feet

it is therefore

ORDERED:-

That the said main drain or common sewer be laid out, made and constructed as aforesaid and the Commissioner of Public Works is hereby authorized and instructed to cause the said main drain or common sewer to be laid out, made and constructed as aforesaid and to report to this City Council after completion of the work the cost thereof and assessments shall be made as provided by law upon the abutting estates as follows:-
