CAMBRIDGE, MASS.

Notice is hereby given that a public hearing will be conducted by the Massachusetts Industrial Finance Agency on Wednesday, December 5, 1984 at 10:00 a.m. at MIFA's offices, 125 Pearl Street, 3rd Floor, Boston, Massachusetts, on the proposal of Moleculon BioTech, Inc. (the "Company") that MIFA approve a project to be located at 230 Albany Street, Cambridge, Massachusetts, consisting generally of the renovation by the Company of an existing four story building presently owned by Sulesky Real Estate Trust including reconfiguration of interior space, replacement of support systems and new roofing and the estimated cost of such project in an amount not less than \$2,733,600, and authorize the financing of such costs by the issuance by MIFA of industrial development revenue bonds under Massachusetts General Laws, Chapters 23A and 40D in an aggregate principal amount not to exceed \$2,733,600, which bonds will not constitute a debt or pledge of the faith and credit of The Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

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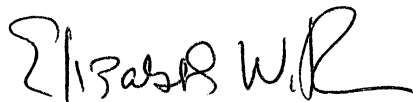
