WHEREAS:-

The Fletcher Grammar School which serves Areas 3 and 4 of the Model Cities Area and part of the Wellington-Harrington Urban Renewal Area was constructed in 1907 and does not provide the physical facilities presently available for children at the new Harrington, Morse and Fitzgerald Schools in the City of Cambridge, and

WHEREAS:-

The proposed Inner Belt which has forestalled planning in this area for several years may never be a reality in the near future and there is a need for action now to provide the best possible education for the children in this area in order that they may compete successfully in the world today, therefore be it

ORDERED:-

That His Honor the Mayor be and hereby is requested to arrange a meeting with the City Manager and the members of the School Committee for the purpose of appointing a committee to select a site for a new Fletcher School which will lie outside any proposed mythical Inner Belt and to further report to this City Council the results of their study at the earliest possible time.
