The Honorable, The City Council:

Attached are two orders requesting the transfer of \$50,000 from the Traffic & Parking Salaries & Wages Account to the Traffic & Parking Other Ordinary Maintenance Account and an appropriation of \$130,000 to the Traffic & Parking Other Ordinary Maintenance Account.

This additional \$180,000 is needed to continue the operation of the East Cambridge and Green-Franklin-Pearl Parking Facilities. The current year is the first full year of operation of the East Cambridge Parking Facility and the estimated cost of operation was underbudgeted, primarily caused by extending the opening hours and weekend openings.

This additional appropriation, however, will be fully funded by additional parking facilities revenue help, generated by these additional opening hours.
