- WHEREAS: This City Council was deeply saddened upon learning of the death of Humberto Cardinal Medeiros, Archbishop of Boston and the religious leader of two million Catholics; and
- WHEREAS: His Eminence has led the Boston Archdiocese since succeeding the late Richard Cardinal Cushing in 1970 and in 1973 was elevated to the rank of Cardinal by the late Pope Paul VI; and
- WHEREAS: The late Cardinal, who was proud of his Portuguese ancestry and his personal blue-collar family background, served in Boston and exercised tremendous leadership and management skills, often times remembering his background, particularly during the racial tensions in the early 1970's, speaking with great conviction about such moral issues as abortion and racial injustice; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That this City Council go on record extending its deepest and most profound sympathy to the late Cardinal's family, Leonee and Manuel Medeiros and his sister Natalia Sousa, at this time of such personal loss; and be it further
- RESOLVED: That the City Clerk be and hereby is requested to forward a suitably engrossed copy of this resolution to the Medeiros family on behalf of the entire City Council.
