In the 1973-1974 budget, the Veterans Services Department requested an appropriation of \$24,000.00 for Memorial Day and other Veterans' functions. This appropriation was reduced to \$20,000.00.

For the past few years, our Memorial Day exercises, and other Patriotic functions in the City of Cambridge, are receiving more and more public attention, especially this year where the Vietnam War is at an end and our boys are returning home. At this time, I would like to bring to your attention that during the next eighteen month period there will be two Memorial Day Parades.

I, therefore, respectfully request an additional \$4,000.00 to cover the constantly rising costs of bands, flags, and wreaths, which are only part of the Memorial Day expenses.


To the Honorable, the City Council:

Your Honorable Body may recall that during the budget hearings there was some discussion on the Veterans' Services Department budget as it relates to one particular item, namely F-11 - Memorial Day.

The Department had requested an appropriation of \$24,000 which was reduced by me to \$20,000. I have now received the enclosed communication from Mr. Reale relative to this same item.
