IN THE YEAR ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND NINETY-THREE

AN ACT

TO INCLUDE IN THE CALCULATION OF STATE-AID A
FACTOR FOR THE PERCENTAGE OF CITY LAND THAT IS
DEVOTED TO TAX EXEMPT INSTITUTIONS

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 68 of chapter 29 as appearing in the 1990 official edition, is hereby amended by adding the following:

(e) There shall be included in the calculation of the local aid guarantee, a factor for the percentage of city land that is devoted to tax-exempt institutions.

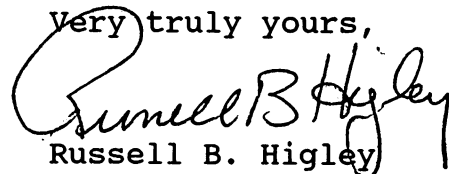

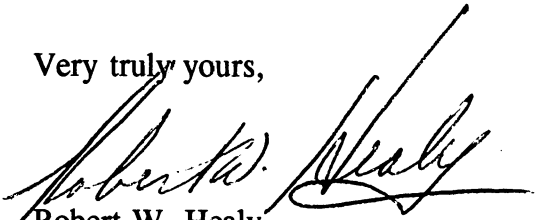
