Kennedy, 43, of Boston, MA, who was killed when the UH-60 Black Hawk helicopter he was traveling in was shot down in Tikrit, Iraq. The Black Hawk was shot down by unknown enemy ordnance on November 7, 2003; and

WHEREAS: Kyran's passing will leave a void in the lives of all his surviving family, his wife, Kathleen (Barb) Kennedy; his sons, Christopher and Kevin; his daughter, Kaitlyn; his parents, J. Kevin and Geraldine (Martin); his brothers, John K. Jr., Reverend William M (Commander, U.S. Navy), Neil P., Christopher R.; his sisters, Kathleen K. Collins, Deidre I. Kennedy, Maura K. Messinger, Kara K. DiSandro, and Patricia E. Kennedy; his sisters-in-law, Margaret and Donna; his brothers-in-law, Mark Collins, Charles Messinger, and Robert DiSandro; his father-in-law Raymond Barb; his mother-in-law Susan Barb; his brothers and sisters-in-law, Patrick, Corinne, Kevin and Denise Barb, and his several nieces and nephews; and

WHEREAS: Kyran will be sorely missed by all he touched and loved; now therefore be it

RESOLVED: That this City Council go on record extending its deepest sympathy to the family of Kyran E. Kennedy at this time of such personal loss; and be it further
