Subject Milk Control Commission relative to Formula used in determining
the price payable to producers for Class II milk.

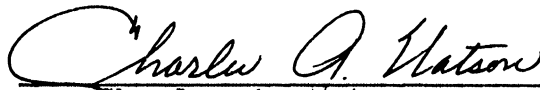
The Milk Control Commission held a hearing on July 11, 1973 relative to the formula used in determining the price payable to producers of Class II milk. The Milk Control Commission as a result of such hearing increased the price of such milk by seventy cents (70¢) per hundred weight.

No one usually appears at the hearings of the Milk Control Commission. The price increase was initiated by the Commission from reports received by it from the United States Department of Agriculture. The price increase directly affects the milk producers in the Berkshires or Western Massachusetts.

Class II milk is unprocessed raw milk containing 40% bottling quality cream.

The price payable to producers of this class milk as of August 1, 1973 is four dollars sixty-four and 9/10th cents (\$4.649) per hundred weight.

The Milk Control Commission's order is designated as Amendment No. 23 to their Official Order No. G-301 as contained in Article IV, Section 3 (1) of the Rules, Regulations and Orders of the Milk Control Commission. A copy of the Amendment is attached.

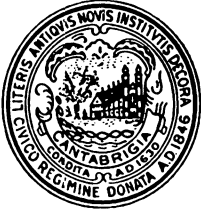
Pursuant to authority granted to the Milk Control Commission by virtue of Chapter 94A of the General Laws, as amended, and all other authority, and as a result of examination and investigation having been made by public hearing, Docket No. 358 held after due notice, and due deliberation having been had, by vote of the members of the Milk Control Commission adopted at their meeting on Wednesday, July 11, 1973, it is hereby

ORDERED: That effective on and after 12:01 A.M., August 1, 1973 Official Order No. G-301, as most recently amended effective April 1, 1973, is hereby further amended as follows:

Section 1. By striking out of Article IV, Section 3 (1), the words "\$1.10 cents", appearing on the last line of said subparagraph (1) and inserting in place thereof the figures "\$1.80", so that said subparagraph (1) will read as follows:

"(1) For such milk received in the milk dealer's plant, a price computed as follows: Divide by 33 the weighted average price per 40 quart can of 40% bottling quality cream in the Boston Market as reported by the United States Department of Agriculture for the delivery period during which such milk is received, multiply this result by 3.5 and add \$1.80."

Section 2. All other Articles, Sections, Paragraphs, and Provisions of said Official Order No. G-301 remain unchanged, and as heretofore and herein amended said order is hereby affirmed, re-adopted and republished.

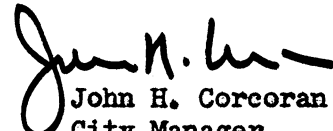
