RESOLVED: That the Cambridge City Council does hereby recognize and express its sincere appreciation to the AIDS Housing Corporation, and in particular Todd Summers and Kristina Hals, for their commitment, leadership, direction, and initiative in the City's continuing endeavor to address the HIV/AIDS pandemic, and, most importantly, the needs of the affected and infected residents of the City of Cambridge.
