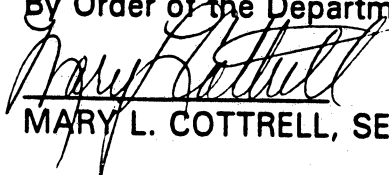
Application of Cellular Payphones, Inc., under the provisions of Chapter 159 of the General Laws as amended, for a certificate as a Radio Utility, for the resale of a Mobile Radio Utility System for compensation within the Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

The petitioner, Cellular Payphones, Inc., is required to give notice of said hearing by publication hereof once at least thirty (30) days prior to said date [on or before February 28, 1994] in the Boston Herald, the Boston Globe, and the Patriot Ledger (Quincy); and to serve a copy hereof at least thirty (30) days prior to said date on all parties on the attached Radio Common Carrier and Cellular companies lists.

Pursuant to 220 CMR 1.03(1), any person who desires to participate in this proceeding shall file a written petition for leave to intervene or to participate in the proceeding at least seven (7) days prior to the date for hearing.

The petitioner is also required to make return of service and publication at the time of the hearing.
