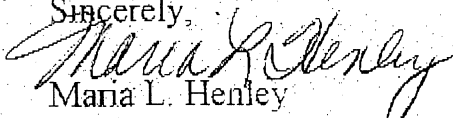
Dear Representative Toomey,

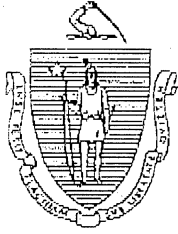
