WHEREAS: It has come to the attention of the City Council that Win Poor is retiring from his position as Program Director for CASPAR Emergency Service Center; and

WHEREAS: Win Poor has served as the Emergency Service Center's Program Director for the past fourteen years. His long and distinguished career has witnessed the successful siting of the shelter at its permanent home at 240 Albany Street, an unprecedented collaboration between the City of Cambridge, CASPAR, and the Massachusetts Institute of Technology culminating in the construction of that shelter, and programmatic growth and change in response to the growing homeless population in Cambridge and across Massachusetts; and

WHEREAS: Between 125 and 140 guests visit the shelter every day, 365 days of the year. CASPAR's Emergency Service Center is the only twenty-four hour shelter in Cambridge and is home to 107 overnight guests each night. Win has established a personal relationship with every shelter guest, has visited them in the hospital and in prison, and has served as a surrogate family member for the one thousand shelter guests served at 240 Albany Street annually; and

WHEREAS: Win is well known, well respected, and well loved by all whose lives he has touched; now therefore be it

RESOLVED: That this City Council congratulate Win Poor, Director of CASPAR on his retirement and give a special thanks for all his dedication, and hardwork on behalf of the homeless members of our community; and be it further
