Dear Mr. Healy:

I am writing to continue the discussion we began over the phone, yesterday afternoon at 5 p.m.

I wish to bring to the attention of the City Council a serious problem which we contend with in my neighborhood of East Cambridge. The park known as Lopez Park, bordered by E.J. Lopez Street, Charles Street and Third Avenue, poses a real danger to the children in the area: it is strewn with broken glass, garbage pawed through by stray dogs, and hardware junk discarded by vendors.

What can we do to clean up this mess? I am - We are- ready and willing to get to work on this park if we can only get direction and funding from the City Council. How do we proceed . Are there any recaptured funds available for use in cleaning up our park.

I am enclosing photographs of the park to show you just how dismal the situation is here. Thank you for your attention to this matter.
