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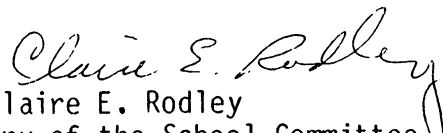
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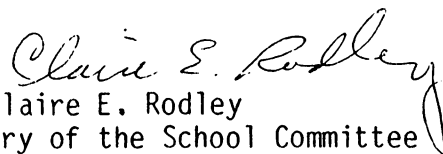

ORDERED:

That Superintendent's Recommendation #85-246, Acceptance of Chapter 188, be adopted as amended as follows: that the School Committee accept Chapter 188 of the Acts of 1985 entitled the Massachusetts Public School Improvement Act of 1985; and further, that it request the Cambridge City Council to do the same. The above motion approved by the Committee and Council is necessary to obtain funds under Chapter 188. The responsibilities are as follows:

I. School Improvement Funds

- A. Appoint one person who is not a parent of a child attending said school building to the School Improvement Council for each elementary school.
- B. School Improvement Funds decisions are submitted by the Superintendent to the School Committee who may veto the expenditure of the funds.

II. Essential Skills Grants

A. Drop-out Prevention Programs:

1. School Committee appoints a drop-out prevention advisory council comprised of administrators, teachers, parents, students and representatives of business, labor, higher education and other community resources. Council members must be broadly representative of the racial and ethnic diversity of the community.
2. School Committee submits the proposal to the Department of Education for evaluation and final approval by December 18, 1985.
3. School Committee must sign off on the proposal by January 24, 1986.
4. Board of Education will make a decision by January 28, 1986.

B. Remedial Programs

1. Grant proposal shall be approved by the local school committee and submitted to the Department of Education for evaluation and approval by December 18, 1985.

2. School Committee must sign off by January 24, 1986.
3. Board of Education will make a decision by January 28, 1986.

III. Early Childhood Discretionary Grant

- A. School Committee must appoint an Early Childhood Advisory Council comprised of a principal, teacher, parent, a member or designee of a local resource and referral agency, and others with experience in the care and education of young children such as early childhood special needs staff members. Council members must be broadly representative of the racial and ethnic diversity of the community.
- B. School Committee submits the proposal to the Department of Education for review and final approval by December 18, 1985.
- C. The School Committee must sign off by January 24, 1986.
- D. Board of Education will make a decision on January 28, 1986.

IV. Professional Development Grants

- A. This section provides \$341,025 in 1986 and \$236,094 in 1987 to be allocated to individual teachers through the Collective bargaining process at the local level.
- ** B. These funds must go to teachers as compensation. The Committee may negotiate an agreement which would result in improving the individual teacher's professional skills and an improved curriculum.
- C. Funds are to be released February 15, 1986.
- D. This section must be negotiated with the C.T.A.
