Dear Mr. Sullivan:

The Youth Resources Bureau is negotiating a grant with the Middlesex County Regional Probation Project. The grant will be for \$6,500, covering the period for July 1, 1976, thru December 31, 1976.

This grant will provide funds to hire a Diversion Project Coordinator.

The intent of this project is to provide Diversion Services to 17-22 years old, first offenders. This alternative to formal involvement with the Justice System for Cambridge residents has the possibility of minimizing their future involvement with the courts. The project will, through case work and supportive services, work with first offenders for a period of 90 days. If during this 90 day period the individuals have shown a willingness to modify their behavior and become involved in productive alternatives i.e: employment, counseling and non deviant activities, the charges filed against the person will be dropped.

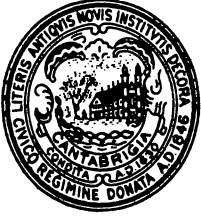
Through this alternative some Cambridge youth will be provided a "second chance". This "second chance" may affect the possibility of an extended court involvement.

Pursuant to this I am requesting an additional appropriation of \$6,500, to the Youth Resources Bureau 1976-77 Budget.


To the Honorable, the City Council:
