To The Honorable, The City Council:

I am hereby requesting the transfer of \$10,000.00 in the General Fund of the Cambridge Police Department from the Extraordinary Expenditures Account to the Other Ordinary Maintenance Account. The Police Department has incurred additional energy costs with the operation of the new vehicle maintenance garage located at the National Guard Armory on Concord Avenue and the Community Policing Service Center (C.O.P.) in North Cambridge. These funds will be allocated as follows: \$5,000 for Commonwealth Gas for the Maintenance Garage and \$5,000 for Commonwealth Electric for both the Garage and the C.O.P. Center.
