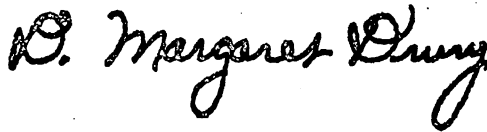

- WHEREAS: The City of Cambridge is committed to improving air quality and reducing traffic congestion because of concern about the levels of automobile travel and congestion; and
- WHEREAS: The City of Cambridge is encouraging the implementation of Transportation Demand Management (TDM) as a means of improving the environment and quality of life by encouraging the use of transportation options (walking, cycling, ridesharing, public transit); and
- WHEREAS: The business community plays an important role in implementing TDM and many Cambridge businesses have already implemented a variety of TDM measures for their employees; and
- WHEREAS: It is important to recognize these TDM efforts which have a significant positive impact on Cambridge residents and the employees of these companies; and
- WHEREAS: Petali Fresh Flowers is a company located in Cambridge and has fewer than 50 employees in Cambridge; and
- WHEREAS: Petali Fresh Flowers offers transit pass reimbursements to its employees, provides transit information to its employees, and delivers flowers by foot or by transit; and
- WHEREAS: Zipcar, Inc is a company located in Cambridge and has fewer than 50 employees in Cambridge; and
- WHEREAS: Zipcar, Inc provides bicycle parking and shower facilities to its employees, offers flexible work hours and telecommuting to its employees, and helps to reduce vehicle miles traveled within the City of Cambridge; and
- WHEREAS: Abt Associates, a company that was founded in Cambridge and has over 50 employees in Cambridge; and
- WHEREAS: Abt Associates offers employees a transit subsidy; provides shuttle service from the Alewife MBTA station, and has recently developed an employee committee to reduce the workplace's ecological footprint, now therefore be it
