Dear Mr. Healy:

The Authority soon will be transferring certain rights-of-way to the City of Cambridge, including one new street which we have heretofore called the western connector. This street is actually an extension of Binney Street and it makes sense to name it Binney Street. To avoid confusion, a portion of existing Binney west of Fulkerson Street should then be renamed Bristol Street, as a natural extension of that street west of Portland Street. Also, there now exists a section of Sixth Street in the Kendall Square project area between Broadway and Main Street which really has no connection with Sixth Street north of Binney Street. This street section actually is an extension of Ames Street and it would seem logical to name it Ames Street.

Since the Council has the responsibility to name streets, this matter is being referred to you for transmittal to the Council. A proposed order is attached for City Council consideration.

We reviewed this matter with the City Engineer, Public Works Department and the Department of Traffic and Parking and secured their concurrence. You will note that these changes effect one existing business, Metropolitan Pipe and Supply. Authority staff will be in contact with representatives of that business to review the matter.

NOW BE IT THEREFORE

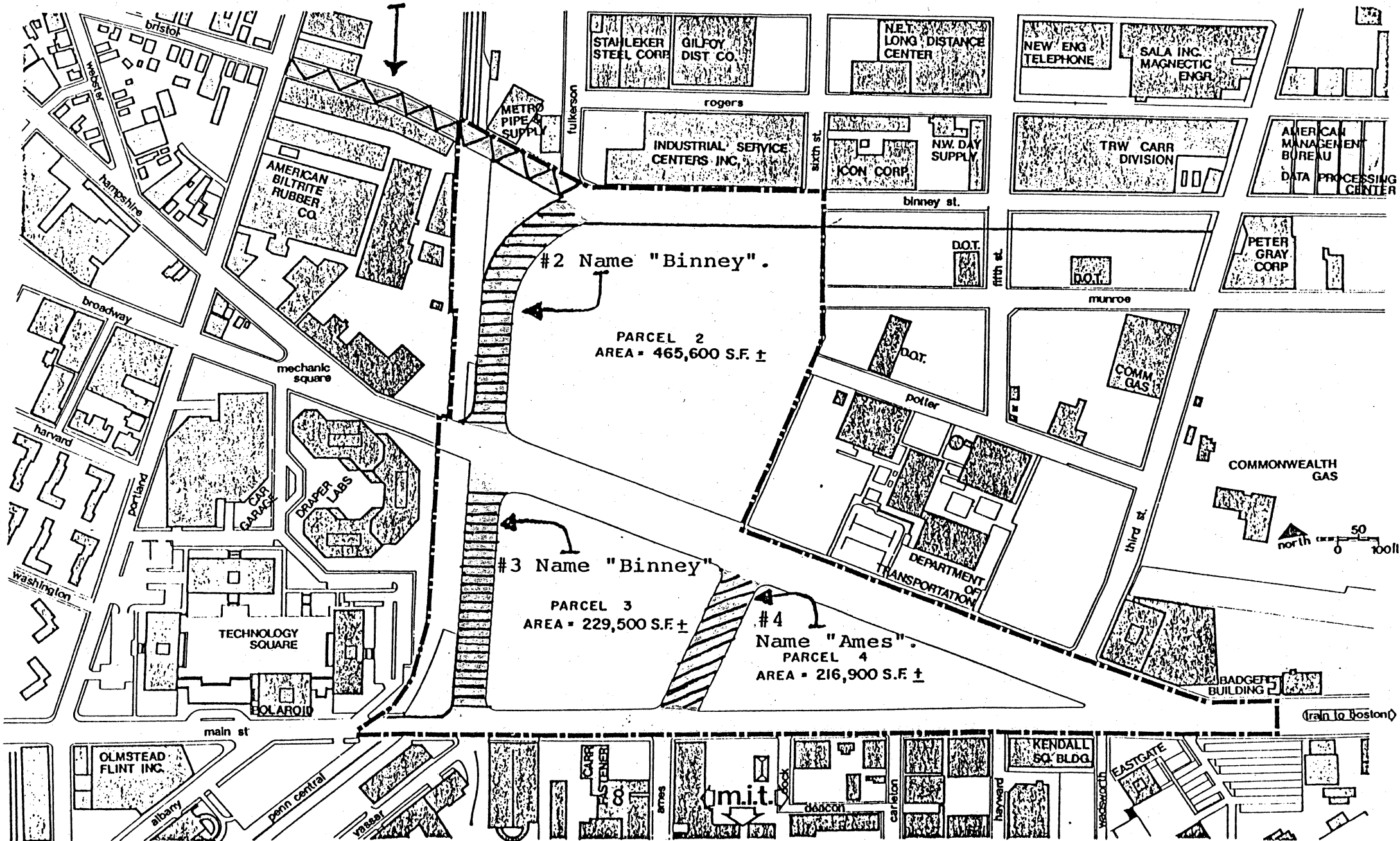
RESOLVED: To name certain rights-of-way in the Kendall Square Urban Renewal Area as follows:

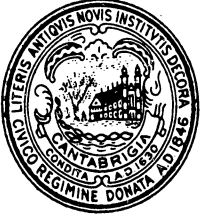
- (1) Change the name of that portion of existing Binney Street located between Portland Street and Fulkerson Street to "Bristol Street";
- (2) Name the new street constructed by the Cambridge Redevelopment Authority along the western boundary of the Renewal Area between Broadway and the existing Binney Street, "Binney Street";
- (3) Name the new street constructed by the Cambridge Redevelopment Authority along the western boundary of the Renewal Area between Main Street and Broadway, "Binney Street"; and
- (4) Change the name of the widened remnant portion of Sixth Street, located between Broadway and Main Street to "Ames Street".

All of the above to be in accordance with the attached plan.
