WHEREAS: Transition House, New England's first shelter for battered women and their children was founded in Cambridge in 1975; and

WHEREAS: During that 25 years, Transition House has provided services and loving support to more than 150,000 women and children; and

WHEREAS: Transition House in Cambridge created the Dating Violence Intervention Project, one of the country's first programs to educate teenagers about violence in personal relationships; and

WHEREAS: On February 15, 2001, at the Museum of Science, Transition House will celebrate its 25th anniversary under the banner, "Love is . . . love isn't" at a gala co-hosted by three local couples, Congressman Michael Capuano and his wife Barbara, State Representative Jarrett Barrios and his partner Doug Hattaway and Middlesex County District Attorney Martha Coakley and her husband, Cambridge Police Deputy Superintendent Tom O'Connor; and

WHEREAS: Transition House will honor attorney and former City Council member Katherine Triantafillou, principal author of the state's first law defining Domestic Abuse and establishing restraining orders, and an original incorporator of Transition House; now therefore be it

RESOLVED: This City Council offers its thanks and congratulations to Transition House for a quarter century of unwavering commitment to ending domestic violence in our homes and relationships and sheltering women and children while assisting them to rebuild their lives in safety; and be it further

RESOLVED: That the City Clerk be and hereby is requested to forward a suitably engrossed copy of this resolution to Transition House at its celebration on February 15, 2001 on behalf of the entire City Council.
