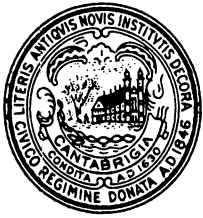


Enclosed is a copy of Mr. Conlon's resume. Mr. Hornig's resume will be forwarded at a later date.
