To The Honorable, The City Council:

Attached please find for your acceptance and appropriation, various private donations totalling \$2,650.00 to the Mayor's Office Salary & Wages Account \$600.00 and Other Ordinary Maintenance Account \$2,050.00, which supported Word-Up, an element of the Mayor's Summer Employment Program. Word-Up was a syndicated radio program, produce by teens through the Mayor's Summer Youth Employment Program with the technical assistance of WGBH - Public Radio in Boston.

This program was packaged as a 60 second radio feature that highlighted societal dilemmas that confront today's urban youth. The feature contained 30 seconds of dramatic interpretation followed by 30 seconds of related commentary. Local radio stations received five features per week for broadcast during the month of September.
