To The Honorable, The City Council:

I am hereby requesting the appropriation of \$63,200.00 in the Grant Fund of the Executive Department (Workforce Development) Other Ordinary Maintenance Account from Employment Resources, Inc. These funds are received from ERI and will be used to build the foundation of a Career Pathways System aimed at creating a sequenced set of educational and youth development opportunities to help youth make the transition from school to work. Specifically, these funds will help to maintain the operation of the Health Careers Apprenticeship Program and provide supplemental case management and mentor support to work-based learning programs, including the Polaroid Technical Internship Program, Harvard Building Facilities Management Program and Cambridge/Lesley Careers in Education; expand business involvement in programs; coordinate the school, work based learning and social support for all programs; develop marketing and outreach materials, cover training, supplies and transportation; and support an evaluation process and final report. The project will be done in partnership with Cambridge Public Schools, Cambridge Community Services and Just-A-Start.
