AN ACT

DESIGNATING THE BRIDGE ON HURON AVENUE OVER
THE BOSTON AND MAINE RAILROAD TRACKS IN THE
CITY OF CAMBRIDGE AS THE MAYOR LEONARD J.
RUSSELL BRIDGE.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the
authority of the same, as follows:*

SECTION 1

The bridge on Huron Avenue over the Boston
and Maine Railroad tracks in the City of Cambridge shall
be designated and known as the Mayor Leonard J. Russell
Bridge.

To the Honorable Senate and House of Representatives of The Commonwealth of Massachusetts
in General Court assembled.

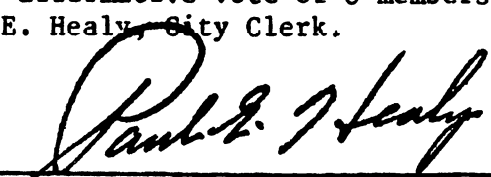
