- WHEREAS: The use of significant federal and state funds for community development is a part of policy setting for the City; and
- WHEREAS: Grant proposals are usually submitted for City Council action at the last minute so that there is little time to discuss them or their broader implications; and
- WHEREAS: This process results in the policy decisions being made by someone other than the City Council which is supposed to be the City's policy making body; therefore, it is
- ORDERED: That the City Manager respond to awaiting report #4 dated April 30, 1984 that requests a better process for City Council review of grant applications well before they are submitted and for a mechanism by which the Council can address the areas into which it believes resources should be put.

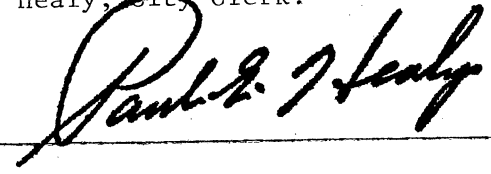
