NEW ENGLAND ENVIRONMENTAL CONFERENCE

The eighth annual New England Environmental Conference will take place at Tufts University on Saturday and Sunday, March 22 and 23, 1986. Speakers and workshop leaders will include Senator Patrick J. Leahy of Vermont, senior minority member of the Appropriations subcommittee that deals with the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA); Rhode Island's Senator John H. Chafee, chairman of the Subcommittee on Environmental Pollution in the Environment and Public Works Committee; Dr. Noel Brown of Jamaica, director of the United Nations Environmental Program in New York; Dr. Evelyn F. Murphy, former Secretary of Economic Affairs in the Commonwealth of Massachusetts; Dr. Brent Blackwelder from the Environmental Policy Institute; Wallace Stickney, Assistant to Governor Sununu of New Hampshire; Joanne Underwood, executive director, INFORM; Major General William Fairbourne, USMC (Ret); Dr. Frank Lowe, Dean, Tufts University School of Veterinary Medicine; Michael Deland, Regional Administrator, Region I, EPA; James S. Hoyte, Esq., Secretary of Environmental Affairs, Commonwealth of Massachusetts; and Dr. Charles Hewitt, Executive Director of Maine Audubon Society.

The conference is sponsored by the Lincoln Filene Center for Citizenship and Public Affairs and is cosponsored by over 188 organizations. It will bring together representatives of business, government, the environment, and other civic organizations. The two-day conference will include over 40 workshops on current environmental issues affecting New Englanders.

Conference Director, Nancy W. Anderson comments, "This two-day 'annual meeting' of those who share a concern for the environment becomes more important each year. As our technological society continues to grow and as we export our technology to the developing world, we begin to see the 'global picture' -- and we know that the work to create and maintain a sustainable world must begin on the local level."
