An Ordinance relating to the Compensation of the
Driver and Members of the Hook & Ladder Company;
And the Forfeiture of Compensation by
Members of the Fire Department

BE it Ordained by the City Council
of the City of Cambridge, as follows

Section One Section forty one of Chapter ten of the
Revised Ordinances is so amended, that from and after
the first day of March 1872, the Driver of the Hook
and Ladder Company shall be paid seventy five dollars
per month, and the Members of said Company
shall be paid One Hundred dollar per year,
payable monthly

Section Two Section fifteen of said Chapter is amended
by repealing all of said Section after the
words "one year" in the fourth line
