WHEREAS: Speaking for a good number of his peers at Harvard Law School, a law student has complained that requests to Continental Cablevision to install cable at the Law School dormitories have been met with little efficiency and response; and

WHEREAS: Apparently, some discussion took place between Continental Cablevision and the students in December, 1990 and early January, 1991, but the process has petered out and there has been no progress; now therefore be it

ORDERED: That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to request the Director of the City's Cable TV Office to communicate with Continental Cablevision's General Manager in an effort to find out what the cause of the delay and the impasse is as well as what the earliest time framework is within which installation of Cable can take place at Harvard Law School dormitories; and be it further

ORDERED: That the City Manager report back to this City Council with the requested data as soon as possible.
