WHEREAS: A good number of complaints have been received from residents on Orchard Street concerning the way the contractor is handling the reconstruction of sidewalks on both sides of the street from Beech Street to Russell Street. In addition to piles of sand on the sidewalks, left at the end of the work day, piles of dirt loft in the street and curb stones askew, no barrels or horses with flashing signal signage to indicate construction - all of these factors area a safety hazard, especially to the elderly residents along Orchard Street many of whom are have a difficult time in entering and leaving their homes; now therefore be it

ORDERED: That the City Manager request the Department of Public Works Commissioner to examine these complaints as soon as possible and assure that remedial steps will be taken to solve the problem momentarily.
