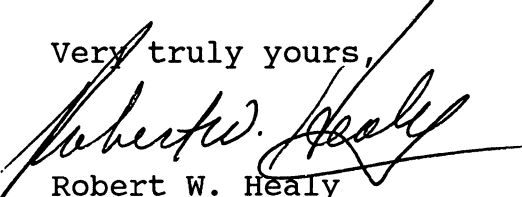
To the Honorable, the City Council:

Attached is an order requesting the transfer of \$26,000 from the Employee Benefits Department Salary Adjustment Account to the Executive Department Other Ordinary Maintenance Account. These funds will be used to conduct initial design work for a new Eastern Cambridge Youth Center.

Work to be performed by consultants retained by the City will include: geotechnical investigations for the subsurface conditions; program meetings and evaluation; preliminary design concepts and models; mechanical/electrical/plumbing and structural systems recommendations; and cost estimates.

It is anticipated that these services will be concluded 6-8 weeks after implementation.
