- WHEREAS: It has been reported that there has been a recent increase in large trucks on Putnam Avenue, causing hazardous conditions; and
- WHEREAS: Among other things, this truck traffic poses a serious threat to the safety of children at the King School; now therefore be it
- ORDERED: That the City Manager see that the police engage in an active enforcement program of all related traffic laws, requiring trucks to follow the letter of law on Putnam Avenue; and be it further
- ORDERED: That the Traffic Department be requested to study the truck traffic to determine whether there is any action that can be taken to reduce this hazard.
