The Honorable, The City Council:

Upon my election as Mayor, I went up to the School Committee and learned of a troubling situation that was waiting for me.

There is a lawsuit pending in Federal District Court involving issues of race, teacher qualifications and desegregation. The parties at suit are the Cambridge School Department, the Cambridge Teacher Association and the Interveners, so called.

I immediately called upon all three parties to try to settle their differences through a negotiated process of mediation. In this way, perhaps the interests of all concerned, especially the kids, could be advanced by saving hundreds of thousands of dollars that would be spent if the case went to trial.

I am pleased to report that all three parties have consented to try mediation. On Friday past, the first session began with all three parties present.

I will keep you posted as the process unfolds.
