WHEREAS: House Bill 3629 is currently before the House Committee on Education; and

WHEREAS: This bill would require that information concerning the "Great Hunger," "The Holocaust," the "Armenian Genocide," and other atrocities against mankind be included in school curriculum; and

WHEREAS: This information should be provided so that future generations will know and learn from the mistakes of the past, so they will never be repeated; now therefore be it

RESOLVED: That the City Council urge all citizens to call the House Education Committee Chair to urge them to report the bill out favorably, and to also contact State Commissioner of Education Robert Antonucci to urge him to include this information in the Social Studies Curriculum Framework which is being discussed presently and also that the City Clerk be in contact with the House Education Committee to record the City Council as being in favor of House Bill 3629 at 722-2070.
