Dear Mr. Sullivan:

The Cambridge Committee of Elders, Inc., at their meeting of October 29, 1974 voted to adopt the following resolutions and ordered that these resolutions be forwarded to you and to the members of the Cambridge City Council.

"Be it resolved, that the Cambridge Committee of Elders, Inc. go on record as supporting the proposed ordinance of the Citizen Participation Structure Committee which calls for an elected city-wide neighborhood based Revenue Sharing Council, which has as its purpose the provision of citizen participation in the use of revenue sharing funds; and which establishes special representation for Senior Citizens on that city-wide committee consistent with the population and special needs of Senior Citizens;

"Be it resolved, therefore, that the Committee of Elders, Inc. go on record as calling for official public hearings for the purpose of discussing such an ordinance, and go on record as calling for the early passage of that ordinance."
