- WHEREAS: It has come to the attention of this City Council that long time Cambridge businessman Benjamin Thompson, President and Founder of Benjamin Thompson and Associates has been named the recipient of the 1987 "Architectural Firm Award" for distinguished architecture for at least a decade; and
- WHEREAS: Benjamin Thompson was one of the creators and original architects of the Faneuil Hall Marketplace, which provided him a new level of national prominence with the opening of Faneuil Hall in 1976, the result of which undoubtedly makes him one of the most influential individuals in the field of architecture; and
- WHEREAS: Thompson Associates has become known for university work, including award-winning dormitories at Colby College, Brandeis University, Harvard Law School and at the Harvard School of Education; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That this City Council go on record extending its heartiest congratulations to Benjamin Thompson for his architectural achievements and formal recognition by the American Institute of Architects; and be it further
- RESOLVED: That the City Clerk be and hereby is requested to forward a suitably engrossed copy of this resolution to Mr. Thompson on behalf of the entire City Council.
