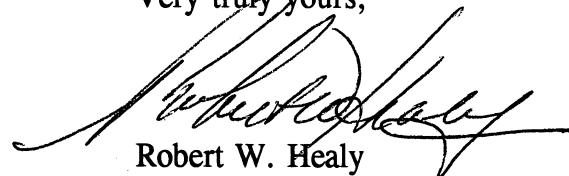
To The Honorable, The City Council:

In response to Awaiting Report Item No. 10, regarding a report on the drainage problems at Buckingham Browne & Nichols, Public Works Commissioner Ralph Dunphy reports the following:

Katherine Craig, the DPW Sewer Division Supervisor spoke with Warren Richards, Director at Buckingham Browne & Nichols (BBN) regarding their drainage problems. BBN is currently locating their drainage pipes and having them cleaned to determine if they need to increase their pipe size.

However, Public Works feels that increasing their pipe size will not relieve drainage problems until the City separates the sewers downstream. This is scheduled to be put out to bid in 1998 as part of the sewer separation project for that area. Design work for this project is scheduled to begin in January, 1997.
