ORDERED:

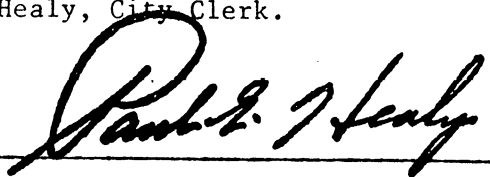

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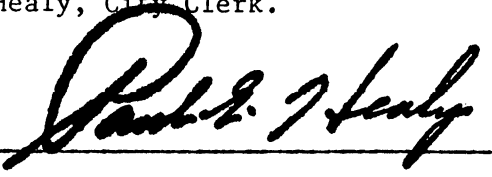

Please be advised that at the City Council meeting of Monday, November 21, 1983, the Council had before it the petition of The Wooden Shoe requesting permission for a projecting sign at the premises numbered 241 Fifth Street (a copy of which is enclosed). Said petition was "tabled" on motion of Councillor Graham, with a letter sent to the petitioner inquiring as to the feasibility of a "flush" sign, rather than a projecting one.

At the meeting, the question was raised that when a sign petition has been approved by a building inspector and the abutting property owners, what is the proper action that the Council should take regarding the petition and any other information that might be of value to the City Council, prior to their approval of the petition as submitted.

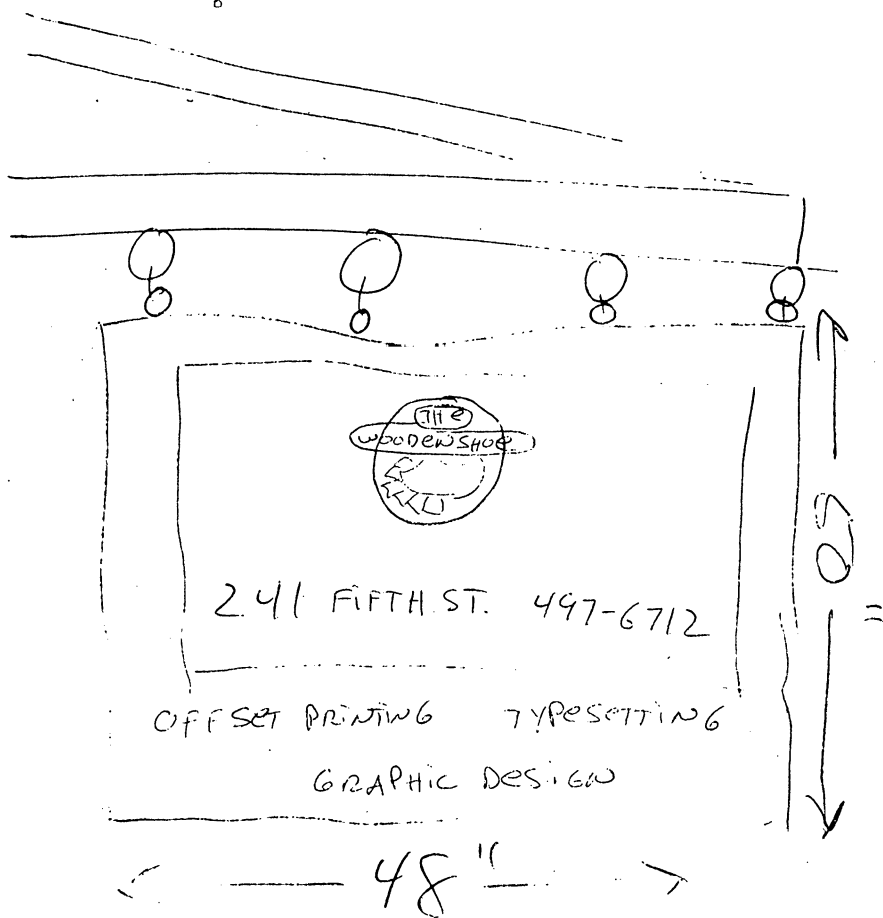

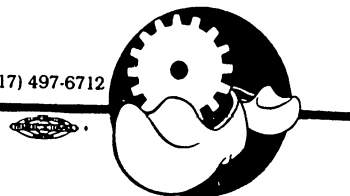

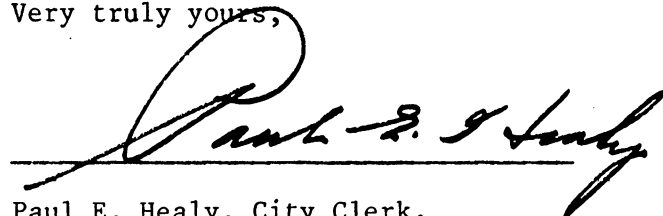
Dear Ms. Stevens:

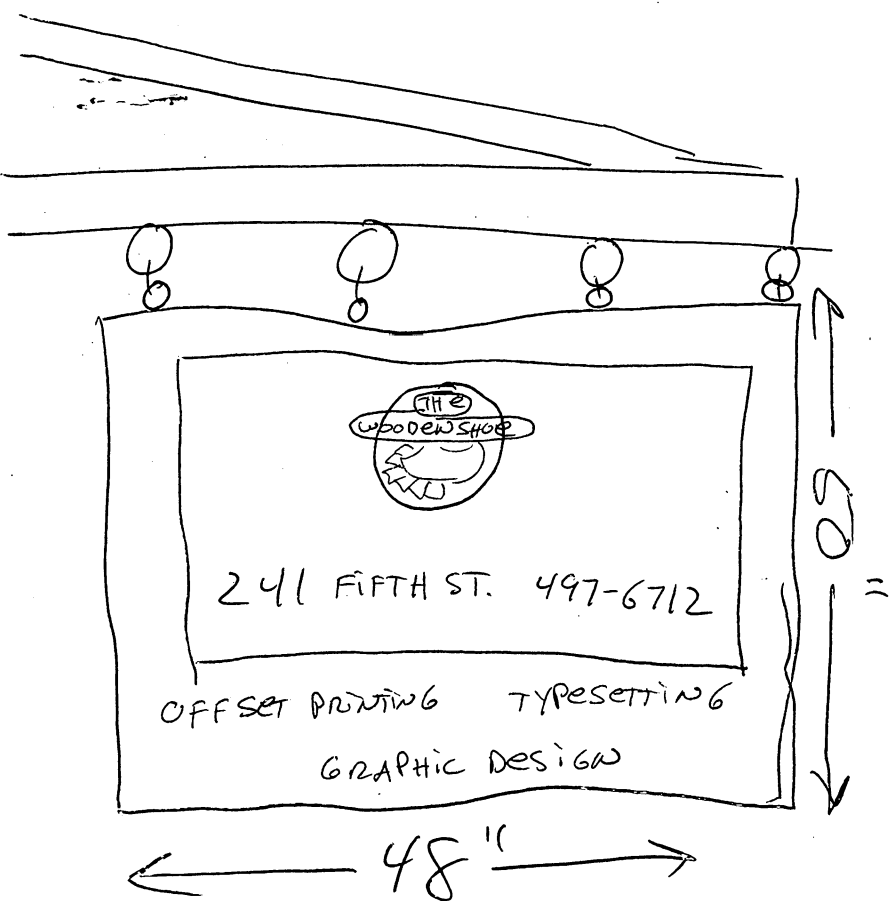

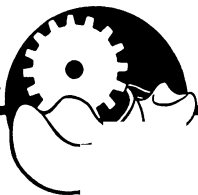
