WHEREAS: Some thirty area employers have agreed to offer these young adults an opportunity to learn about their business first -hand. These companies include Lotus Development, Polaroid Corporation, Au Bon Pain Company, Inc., Massachusetts Institute of Technology and many others; and

WHEREAS: Open Minds/Open Doors participants may work in a temporary job and earn money while they explore different vocations and can help young people determine what additional education and training they need for their field of interest - and can motivate them to pursue that education or training, and for many result in a job; now therefore be it
