

In reference to City Council Order of Jan. 18, 1955, regarding the increasing of the lumens on Lopez St., please be advised that there are two 1000 lumen lights on this street at present. It is especially dark at the Brookline St. end, and I would recommend increasing the present 1000 lumen light at #30 Lopez St. to 2500 lumens, also discontinue the present 1000 lumen light at #20 Lopez St. and install one 2500 lumen light at #6 Lopez St. This should result in a better uniformity of light on the entire Street.




