WHEREAS: The Massachusetts Bay Transportation Authority has scheduled a public hearing to discuss their proposed enhancements and reductions in their bus routes for November 10 at the Mt. Auburn Veterans of Foreign Wars Post 8818 at 688 Huron Avenue; and

WHEREAS: The location is not convenient to residents who do not own a car or who are otherwise planning to ride mass transit to the meeting; and

WHEREAS: That date immediately precedes the Veterans Day holiday on November 11 and many people who ordinarily would attend may not be able to because of previous commitments to be out of town; and

WHEREAS: The City of Cambridge recognizes the importance of community input into changes in MBTA service and encourages the MBTA to gather information from as broad a cross section of the community as possible; now therefore be it

RESOLVED: That the City of Cambridge protests the date and location of the public hearing and requests that the MBTA reschedule the meeting for a more convenient place and date; and be it further

RESOLVED: That the City Clerk send copies of this resolution to the Chairman and General Manager of the MBTA.
