Dr. Harold Nash Jr., 72

Was hospital chief of surgery.

Dr. Harold Edward Nash Jr. of West Roxbury and Hull, retired chief of surgery at Carney Hospital in Dorchester, died Tuesday in his home in West Roxbury. He was 72.

Dr. Nash was born in Boston. He graduated from Boston College and earned his medical degree at Tufts Medical School.

He served in the Army Medical Corps during World War II.

In addition to being chief of surgery at Carney, Dr. Nash was on the staffs at Youville, Pondville, Bethany and St. Elizabeth's hospitals. He also had been clinical professor of surgery at Tufts University School of Medicine.

After his retirement in 1989, he was part-time physician at the Liberty Mutual Industrial Clinic in Boston.

He leaves his wife, Mary G. (Costello); six daughters, Mary Gordon of Sanford, N.C., Barbara A. Chassaigne of Sudbury, Elizabeth P. Nash of Stoneham, Rosemary Nash of West Roxbury, Joanne Tobin of Walpole and Christine E. Nash of West Roxbury; seven sons, Harold E. 3d of Canton, Christopher G. of Granger, Ind., Edward J. of Walpole, John G. of Roslindale, Stephen J. of Stoneham, Joseph A. of Natick and Philip A. of Charlestown; a brother, Francis J. of Milton; and 22 grandchildren.

A funeral Mass will be said at 11 a.m. tomorrow in St. Theresa's Church in West Roxbury. Burial will be in St. Joseph's Cemetery in West Roxbury.
