In Board of Aldermen, June 22 1870

The Committee on Roads & Bridges to which were referred sundry Petitions for Edgestones & Sidewalks, having examined the premises referred to would respectfully Report.

That the usual Order of Notice be issued to the abutters ^{Recommending} that this Board intends to pave the sidewalk with brick on the northerly side of Winter Street between 3d. & 4th streets, as prayed for by H. McNevey & others.

On both sides of Gore street between 3d. & 4th. streets, - where not already done, - as prayed for by T. Sheridan & others

That this Board intends to set Edgestones on Spring Street between 2d. & 3d. streets, & on 2d. street between Spring & Thornelike Streets, in accordance with the Petition of Charles M. Monroe & others

That this Board intends to set Edgestones & pave the sidewalk with brick on the westerly side of 3d. street from the North corner of a vacant lot in the rear of the Swelling House of Abram Watson to the corner of Spring Street & on Spring street from 3d. to 4th. & to move the fences on said streets to conform to the lines of the streets as prayed for by Oliver Welch & others.

That this Board intends to set Edgestones on the northerly side of Mount Auburn Street from Putnam to Holyoke Streets, as prayed for by Octavius Howe & others.

That this Board intends to construct a brick sidewalk from Holyoke street on the westerly side of Winthrop Square to Mount Auburn Street, & on the southerly side of Mount Auburn Street from Winthrop Square to Eliot Street in accordance with the Petition of S. M. Taylor & others.

That this Board intends to set
Edgestones on the Westly side of
Holyoke street from Winthrop to South
streets, as prayed for by Benj. F. Myeth
and others
