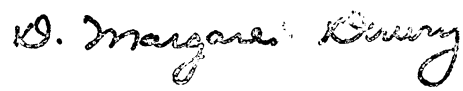

To The Honorable, The City Council:

I am hereby requesting the appropriation of \$652,800.00 in the Public Investment Fund of the Community Development Department Extraordinary Expenditures Account from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development. As a major element of the National Affordable Housing Act of 1990, the HOME Investment Partnership Act, i.e. the HOME Program, was established to provide financial assistance to help states and municipalities expand their supply of decent, safe and affordable housing. The City has been allocated \$652,800 in State HOME funds through the Massachusetts Executive Office of Communities and Development to be used for the construction of affordable first-time homebuyers units on the Hampshire/Columbia Street site and substantial rehabilitation of rental units in the Swartz Properties.
