An Ordinance
in amendment to an Ordinance in
relation to Streets.

Be it ordained by the City Council
of the City of Cambridge, as follows:-

Section 16, of Chapter 36 of the Revised
Ordinances is hereby amended by adding at
the end thereof, the following:- "Before any
^{which} ~~by the~~ ^{water-board, gas Co. or any other person}
^{opening} shall be made under the provisions
^{or corporation} of this section, notice ^{thereof} shall be filed in the
office of the City Engineer, giving full
information as to the time when and the
point where ^{by whom} in any street, lane, alley, side-
walk or other public place, any such opening
is to be made, or any obstruction caused;
and the City Engineer shall immediately
thereupon give notice of the same to the
Superintendent of Streets and the Chief Engi-
neer of the Fire Department. The person,

department, or expiration, making such opening or causing such obstruction, shall be held responsible for any damages that may result from the work so done, for a period of six months from the time of making such opening or causing such obstruction.
