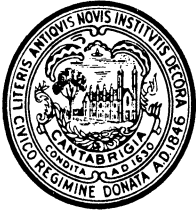

In regard to a communication from Gertrude M. Potter concerning her property tax assessment for the premises numbered as 50 Haskell Street, similar two-family houses of like size and kind, although rare, were compared on an exterior field inspection. The property was inspected during the original neighborhood interior inspection, and the property record card was signed by Gertrude M. Potter. The taxpayer has been contacted by telephone to discuss the property tax assessment which appears to be at full and fair cash value as of January 1, 1984; therefore, she has agreed that no additional inspection is necessary. The building value of \$91,800.00 and the land value of \$53,100.00, for a total value of \$144,900.00, will remain unchanged for this fiscal year.
