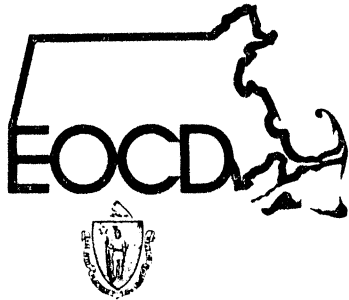

A Certificate of Appointment is enclosed for your records. In order for you to make your appointment final, it will be necessary for you to:


1. Take your Certificate of Appointment to the office of the Town Clerk and take your oath of office before him; and



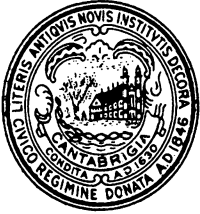


