In the year One thousand Eight Hundred and
Seventy six,

An Ordinance in relation to payment of City Employees,

Be it ordained by the City Council of the City of
Cambridge, as follows,

Sec. One, Heads of departments shall furnish monthly pay-
rolls of employees in their respective departments,
stating the name of each employee, the time for which
payment is to be made, the rate of wages and the
amount due him,

Sec. Two, The City Treasurer shall in person, or by his
clerk pay each employee of the City, his authorized
agent or attorney; - shall take therefor the receipt
of no other person than such employee, agent or
attorney; - and may, whenever it is reasonably nec-
essary to save loss of time to the employees, send a
clerk with the necessary funds to such localities
as may be convenient for paying the men,
