The recent explosion and fire in Kendall Square made it very clear that Cambridge must be careful to monitor all types of explosives and dangerous materials that pass through our City, and

WHEREAS:

Due to the large number of high technology institutions and companies that we have, it is likely that a great deal of dangerous materials pass through our city, therefore be it

ORDERED:

That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to contact the State Commissioner of Public Safety, the State Commissioners of Highways and of Public Works, and a representative from the United States Department of Defense in order to arrange for a public hearing on this matter before the City Council.
