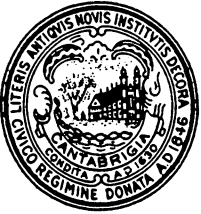
We will be meeting with the MDC to discuss this as well as other problems related to the City and as soon as we have anymore information on this matter I will relate to you.

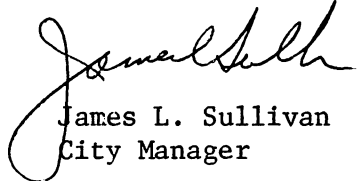
